In-Person Meeting Regulations

As a member of Advanced Robotics (AR) and a student at The University of Texas at San Antonio (UTSA), I hereby sign this contract in agreement that I understand and will abide by the regulations for in-person meetings set forth below by the Advanced Robotics Executive Board:

Regulations:

- Students are HIGHLY encouraged to wear a mask when entering the Advanced Robotics Lab.
- Sanitation & disinfection materials must be utilized and present at all times.
- Sanitization & disinfection must be performed before and after each meeting. Members seen not abiding will be given a warning before being suspended for a one week period from any in person activities.
- No physical contact is allowed between members at the meeting.
- All meetings must be requested to the Advanced Robotics' Executive Board through the submission of In-Person Project Meeting Request form.
- If you have been exposed or believe to have been exposed to anyone with COVID-19, you are to report this to an AR Officer and avoid contact with AR Members (and not attend any in person meetings or events until after you have been quarantined for a 10-day period) this is subject to change based on the CDC's and UTSA's recommendation
- IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING ANY OF THE SYMPTOMS OUTLINED BY THE CDC YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO ATTEND ANY IN PERSON MEETINGS UNTIL AFTER YOU HAVE BEEN QUARANTINED FOR A 10-DAY PERIOD
